





On April 1, 1972, the pastor of a local church left his wife a letter. In the letter, the pastor outlined how she should handle the children, how she should handle the finances and what her first actions should be to minimize the damage to the church and household. He had been involved in an affair and was leaving her to be with the other woman, who had been his wife's best friend.

Nineteen years later, on April 1, 1991, another pastor left his wife a letter. In the letter, he outlined how she should handle the children, how she should handle the finances, and what her first actions should be to minimize the damage to the church and household. He had been involved in an affair and was leaving her to be with the other woman, who had been his wife's best friend.

The first pastor was my father. I was ten years old when he divorced my mother. I had no information regarding the day he left. I had no information regarding the letter he wrote. All I knew was my dad was a pastor who had divorced my mother when I was ten years old.

The second pastor, who left his wife 19 years later, was me! When my mother read the letter I had left for Kathy, she told me it was déjà vu. The letter I had left for

Kathy was virtually identical to the one my dad had left for her 19 years ago, to the day.

Although the stories began identically, they are unfolding differently. My father and my mother divorced and went their separate ways. Kathy and I, however, remained married – and in October of 2004 we celebrated the 20th anniversary of our marriage by renewing our wedding vows on stage at the Houston Astrodome during an historic evening when Charles and Frances Hunter led their final Healing Explosion.

When our marriage was going through its worst times I was a master at manipulating Kathy. I did it in a manner that would enable me to convince anyone in our world that Kathy was at fault for any problem we had.

Boiled down to the bottom line, the problems all worked like this: Kathy would express a need. I was childish and therefore the need would touch my insecurities and overwhelm me. I could not bring myself to simply meet her need.

I despised any signs of weakness in Kathy. Instead of embracing her when she would express a need, I would be repelled. I would recoil in anger at her attempts to touch a place of tenderness in me. My insecurities stopped me from welcoming her into my heart and propelled me away from lovingly meeting her need. Understand that I was often tender but it was always on my terms and in my

timing, yet when Kathy needed and requested tenderness from me, it was not available.

Instead the walls would go up and I would say something to put her off. "You don't need a hug right now." "You don't need to talk to me. You need to talk to God." "I did not look at you in a condescending way."

From here things would escalate to the point where Kathy would scream or throw a plate at me! Now I had my ammo! I had all the proof that I needed to justify that I was the good guy. Kathy was unstable!

When we landed in Colorado for the Life Skills Ministry seminar on marriage counseling I had years of evidence of Kathy causing problems in our marriage.

I had been successful at convincing everyone in our world that Kathy was the source of the trouble in our marriage. When Kathy would reach out to a pastor or anyone else who might help, I could easily convince the person that Kathy was to blame. If I had read this paragraph at the time, my response would have been, "Well, that is just great for you, but in my marriage, Kathy really is the one at fault." Not only would I have said this, I would have firmly believed it. Compounding our problems was that Kathy had been "duped" by wrong teaching in the church; teaching that told her that God could "fix" our marriage if she would only submit, respect me and pray more. This is a recipe for failure in a troubled

Christian marriage. Is there any wonder that we have a 50% divorce rate in the Body of Christ?

We sat for the first few hours as the founder of Life Skills International, Paul Hegstrom, emphasized the role of men in a relationship and **their responsibilities** to their wives. Finally, I could stand it no more. I publicly asked Paul, "Okay, so we have been talking to men for a few hours now. When do we talk about what the women have to do?"

To this he replied, "When a man gets his issues

straight and meets his wife's needs, most of her issues will go away and she will begin to respond in a positive way." I did not like that answer! That answer insinuated that our problems might partially be my fault when clearly they were all Kathy's fault! I just knew that I could convince Paul of this fact if given the

chance, so I waited for my opportunity.

A few more hours into the training, I repeated the question in another manner. "Can't the woman be the problem? The man is not always the problem in marriage." Of course I gestured toward my problem wife! This continued into the second day until Dr. Hegstrom finally had enough. He told me point blank that I was the problem in my marriage. He told me that Kathy

was desperate to have a great marriage relationship for that is how God made her.

He continued, saying that my issues had caused the problems in our marriage and that if I would get healed and change that I would have a most incredible wife. He emphatically stated that she might have some very minor issues that need to be addressed but that she will deal with those on her own **after** I have dealt with mine.

Paul told me that God made Kathy a responder and that her problems were a reflection of her responding to my treatment of her. He said that when I grow up and

lay my life down for my wife as Christ did for the church that I would be amazed at how wonderful a wife I have.

I could not admit when I did something wrong. My insecurities were too deep, my pride

insurmountable. I felt like I would lose something if I admitted that I had made a mistake. As God began to let me see our marital problems in the light of truth it all began to dawn on me. I had been the problem all along! If only I had been dead to myself while being willing to meet my wife's needs, we would not have had 99% of our problems.

My growing up and meeting Kathy's needs was a very difficult process. Paul Hegstrom and a lady pastor that Kathy would confide in both told her that the time would have been shortened had she separated from me. It was a personal decision that Kathy made not to leave. We never tell women that they are required to stay in an abusive situation regardless of whether the abuse is physical, mental, emotional or spiritual.

Kathy has always been dedicated and committed to our having a successful marriage. She looked for every positive sign that I was making progress and that there was hope for our relationship.

I almost broke this

mechanism in her, but by the grace of God, Kathy stuck with it. In the recovery years after Life Skills, she was not just blindly "standing" with no relief in sight. Kathy was holding me accountable to change using what we learned and had the "right" to speak up regularly in defense of herself. It was my job to acknowledge her concerns and change.

It was difficult for me to bring down the walls of "self protection" in my heart when Kathy expressed a

need to bond with me. It was not just difficult. It was almost impossible. I could not stand the negative feelings that were generated in me when she would ask me to "listen to her heart" or "listen to her feelings." She was hurting and I was the cause. I did not want to hear that!

I protected myself from bonding with Kathy by "throwing down the gauntlet" regularly. If we were

discussing something and I wanted to quit talking about it I would tell Kathy that the subject was closed. She would try to get me to talk it out in order to get that all-important sense of closure. I would tell her that she was being rebellious and unsubmissive. "I said that the conversation is over and so it is over! I am the head of this house and it is sin for you to demand

that we talk further about it. You have to repent and get your heart right."

A horrible example was when I came back from the adultery. I demanded, "The adultery is over. I have repented and you can never mention it again." I was too insecure to handle the "feeling" of her pain.

For three years I could not bring myself to embrace the depths of hurt that my action had caused. I did not want to "go there." Adultery hurts a wife worse

emotionally than any other thing that a husband can do. A husband who does this is the "lowest of the low." It is amazing that these same husbands still see themselves as "God's gift to women!"

Male adulterers are almost incorrigible flirters! Kathy had to point out to me repeatedly for a couple of years when I was flirting so that I could recognize and stop it! The first few times Kathy said that I was flirting I resisted her but then I started to recognize the pattern. Listen to your wife, men. God gave her to you to help you grow up and become the man that He has called you to become!

I put a lot of effort toward loving Kathy in those first ten years of marriage. It was on my terms, of course. I would pour out tokens of love on her, we had regular "date nights" like all of the marriage books suggest and I made sure that all of the special occasions were celebrated.

We always have enjoyed plenty of lovemaking while at the same time Joel would not be sensitive to my thoughts and feelings.

I tried everything that I could to make our marriage a success including reading many books on submission and practicing what they taught. I

dedicated myself to making sure that everything was done Joel's way. I would leave love notes and cards in places he would find them. All the books told me to do this. I enjoyed it but it seemed like he could have cared less.

Joel had me convinced that everything was my fault and that if I would just get "right" then our marriage

would be great... After all, he was the "knight in shining armor!" I just did not **appreciate** all that he was doing for us.

The four years that immediately followed the adultery were the most difficult years for me. Joel's controlling nature and lack of sensitivity continued to keep our marriage on pins and needles. It was during this time that the grace and peace of God in my life was greatly tested.

Did I ever feel like quitting? You bet! There were many times I thought I was going to have to leave concluding, "Enough is enough." But I had the dream, the vision, the prophetic word that God had spoken and I could not let it go. It broke my heart to think that God's dream for us might not come to pass. If we had been exposed to better information, our bad years could have been shortened. At that point in our history, I only had the "wives should just pray for, submit to and respect their husbands" message. This wrong message (that Joel loved) extended our misery.

Joel discovered that he could use the Word to justify his inflicting emotional abuse upon and playing mental head games with me. I called Joel my "iron fist." The iron fist would come down anytime I disagreed with him or asked him to treat me with respect.

There was no talk of mutual submission as the Word of God teaches. If I questioned Joel's authority and position as head of our home then I was that "nagging wife and dripping faucet" that Proverbs warned him about!

We teach husbands to love their wives as Christ loves the church and gave his life. For the sake of discussion, I am going to assume that your husband will read this book and "buy into" the ideas we present. If he starts to change before your very eyes, what will you do?

You may have been very hurt and you may not want to trust. You might not believe that the changes your husband is going through are real. This is a normal reaction. It may be a while before you begin to trust again. It took six months before I believed that what I was experiencing was real. While we were in Colorado, God had given me a vision of an apple seed. This represented the great work he had begun in Joel.

Would that seed grow on its own? No! When God says **He** is going to do something, He often means that He will **help you** do it! I had a part to play by responding to the changes that God was working in Joel. As I

responded to the changes that were occurring in him, God made additional changes in me.

Christ laid his life down for the church. As we respond by giving our lives to Him He is able to work in us and make us the bride He needs us to be. Marriage works in this same way. As your husband loves you unconditionally, laying his life down for you, it is easy for you to respond positively.

"We have worked out a comfortable living arrangement. I am content in that."

If your wife would answer along the lines of the latter options then we have some work to do!

Anthony told me that his marriage was miserable. He and Samantha owned two restaurants and they really had no relationship at all. He ran one restaurant while

Samantha tended to the second. According to Anthony, divorce seemed to be their only option.

I mentioned to Anthony that Kathy and I did marriage counseling and that I could help him if he would like. He consented to listen so I gave him a 15-minute crash course in marriage. I told him that the reason he had a bad marriage was most likely because he was not listening to his wife and that he probably had quit meeting her needs years ago.

He nodded his head so I continued, "The facts are, Anthony, that men do not have a clue how to meet their sweetheart's needs. Your wife probably gets on your case all the time about things that she thinks you are doing wrong in your relationship doesn't she?" Anthony smiled a bit again, agreeing with my statement.

I then offered this gem. "I bet that you feel henpecked, don't you?" This revolutionary insight also received a positive reaction. I explained to Anthony that the way for a man to quit feeling hen-pecked is to simply do what his wife asks him to do the first time that she asks. Most men let their pride get in the way and they resist everything that their wife asks them to do. I told him that his wife desperately wanted a good relationship with him and if he would simply do the things that she has been asking him to do and take time to listen to her heart she would open up to him and their marriage would drastically improve.

Anthony happily reported that he did what I suggested and that he and his wife were getting along really well. I have been in touch with Anthony twice a year and he continues to tell me that they are doing well. Fifteen minutes changed his life.

A year later I stopped at their restaurant and Samantha was acting as hostess. She had a peaceful and relaxed look about her even in the midst of people waiting in line to get a table and a lot of general confusion on the busy night. Knowing that men always think that their marriages are more successful than they really are, I asked Samantha how things were going with Anthony and she also reported that things were going well.

Anthony and Samantha did not read this book. Anthony and Samantha have not been to our marriage seminar nor have they attended our church. Fifteen minutes of **truth** and a **committed response** was the key to saving their marriage and giving them a happy relationship.

Chapter Six

Rate Your Marriage On A Scale of 1–10

How do you rate your marriage on a scale of 1–10? How would your wife rate your marriage? This is your starting point. The only way to measure the current state of your marriage is to honestly evaluate it.

More than likely, your wife will be wary of this exercise. Chances are that when talking about your relationship she has been met with a deaf ear, ridicule, arguments or justifications.

In order to get an **honest** evaluation from your wife you must guarantee her a "safe place". There are three places that must be safe in life: family, church and friendships. In most homes it is not safe for the wife to tell her husband that she is unhappy in their relationship. Begin by assuring her that you would like an honest estimation of your marriage in order to work on **your** issues that might be contributing to any discord in your relationship.

Most men will rate their marriages about a 7-9 on a scale of 1-10. Their wives will normally rate **the same**

marriage a 5-7! This is completely normal. Women spend a lot more time "feeling" about their marriage relationship than men do.

The wife on the other hand does not section these things off as well. If there are issues that have not been brought to closure they stay with her. In her mind the whole marriage is difficult because of the unsolved issue. She is incredulous that hubby can just go on to other interests in life while she is left frustrated.

When our family was on the road full time for the purpose of recovery after the adultery we had opportunity to eat out often and enjoy family activities. I was in sales work at the time. I could not understand why Kathy was not being lighthearted, carefree and happy. This

was very frustrating to me and caused many arguments.

I could not do this simple thing. I had to be in control. I had to keep Kathy off balance. I would tell her that she was ridiculous and wrong to "hold onto her pain." I forbade her to bring the subject up. It was classic control and manipulation emanating from unwillingness

on my part to embrace her pain. I refused to give Kathy a safe place to share her heart, her hurts and especially her deeply felt feelings. It was easier to just tell her that everything she said and felt was wrong.

There are some things that you can do that are very easy to help the process. Shining your crown is a good place to start. Compliment your wife, build her up, praise her and be sure that she realizes that you value her over friends, hobbies, work or ministry. Her value cannot consist of, "After Bible study, after prayer, after work, after church; if there is any time left we will spend that together."

Let her know that you really **want** to begin working on improving your weak areas. Assure her that you can only do this is if she is totally, perhaps even brutally honest. Tell her you are going to be a big boy and take your medicine without arguing, justifying, berating or accusing! If you can get your wife to open up then you will have successfully completed step one on this road to marital bliss!

Chapter Seven

Your Personal Marriage Manual

Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honor unto the wife as unto the weaker vessel and as being heirs together of the grace of life that your prayers be not hindered.

I Peter 3:7

Live with your wife according to knowledge, so that your prayers will not be hindered.

God has equipped every woman with a marriage manual in her heart, which is custom designed to instruct her husband in how to meet her individual and unique needs. A man who can learn how to tap into this marriage manual and heed its instructions will have all of the information needed on how to have heaven on earth in his marriage.

God did not give this marriage manual to men. A man is basically born without a clue as to how to meet his wife's needs. You are reading this book, which probably means you have a desire to experience a good marriage.

The goal of this book is really to help you to turn your heart toward your wife and be willing to become the husband she needs you to be by listening to her heart.

Many wives are quite vocal. For the first few years of marriage they will attempt to communicate to their husbands what it is that they need from them in order to

feel loved. The problem many times is that the husband thinks that he knows what is best for the marriage! Perhaps he has books read some on Perhaps marriage. understands some general principles of marriage that have helped other couples. Thinking he knows how to meet his wife's needs, he begins to feel like his wife is

attempting to manipulate him when she shares her heart with him. After years of trying to communicate her desires a wife will finally give up.

If it were not my idea, I would resist! If she wanted to talk, I would buy her flowers. If she wanted to get some flowers, I would take her out to dinner. I was insistent that Kathy be grateful and thankful for the expressions of love that I wanted to show to her instead of listening and responding to her heart.

Controlling husbands can often be considered "great guys" to onlookers and even to their wives. They can be charming, romantic, good providers, they can go out of their way to do nice things and at times they can be extremely attentive. I was all of these, when I wanted to be.

Kathy's marriage manual often told me that I was not spending enough time with her. My reaction was to tell her that we were together in the house all day and that she should be happy because most guys had to leave the house to go to work. At least I worked at home and she was with me all day. She would inform me that the dog also was in the house with us! Kathy's marriage manual also told me that I often looked at her in a condescending way. To this I would reply that she was too sensitive and needed to "get a grip".

Your wife is equipped with "red flags" and "warning buzzers". When you do not treat her correctly those red flags will be waving in her heart. When she shares these concerns with you, your first reaction many times will be to resist, deny or argue the point. If you can realize at this point that you are called to love your wife as Christ loved the church and gave his life for her then it will be much easier for you to listen and respond positively to your wife's request.

Kathy's marriage manual "red flags" would really go off when she would make a mistake and I would give

her that much-used "put-down look" that was often accompanied by condescending words.

This tactic kept Kathy off balance, causing her to doubt herself, which was my desired outcome as an abusive husband. Her marriage manual would tell me that I was acting like something was wrong with **her** because she made a mistake when it was simply a part of life. This really hurt her feelings. My response was to get defensive and angry, basically telling her to toughen up. Again, I did not have a clue.

It is very simple. When your wife's marriage manual points out that you have violated her in some way, your job is to hear her heart and accept what it is that your personal marriage manual is saying to you.

For many years, Kathy had **no voice** in our marriage. She could not talk to me without losing. I could turn anything around and then spend hours bringing the message home to her as to why her thoughts and feelings were illegitimate. Naturally, only my thoughts and feelings were right! Kathy resorted to writing letters to me so that she could bring her thoughts across to me "just right" and without interruption. She would spend up to three days perfecting the letters utilizing the sandwich theory. She would compliment me on what I did right, give me the bad news and end by again telling me something positive.

This tactic did help her cause occasionally. The majority of the time, even these letters did not move me. I really disliked receiving the letters! I would read the masterpiece that she had labored and agonized over. In a

IF YOU DO NOT TAKE YOUR WIFE'S HEART SERIOUSLY, SHE WILL EXPLODE. huff I would scribble my argumentative replies in the columns and leave the letter for her to find. Sometimes she would change her mind and not even give me a letter that she had prepared. Now those were the letters that I liked!

If you ever hope to become the man that God has called you to be you will have to let your wife know that it is safe for her to share her heart with you. Tone of voice, eye contact, facial expressions, show of interest, sincere desire and patience with the answers are all part of the message you send. You will have to promise that you will not ridicule, belittle or argue with her over the things she shares. If you have been caustic to her needs for years this might take a while. You may have violated her trust so many times that she has closed the marriage manual.

Your job is to convince her that it is safe to try again.

This time you will listen.

In Proverbs 18:22, "good" is the Hebrew word "towb," one of the twelve Hebrew words for prosperity. It also means "good in its widest sense; beautiful, best, better, cheerful, at ease, prosperous, bountiful, fine, glad, joyful, loving, merry, most pleasant, sweet; favor, pleasure, kindness, goodness, wealth and to be well favored." The promise is that your wife will be good for you! She will be

beautiful, the best, cheerful and bountiful. Your wife will bring you favor. She will be joyful, loving, merry, most pleasant and sweet. Your wife will add wealth to your life. Selah. Pause and think calmly about that!

This word "towb" also refers to the glory and the goodness of God! In Exodus 33:19, Moses asked God to

Husbands, love your wives as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her.

Agree with your adversary quickly!

Your wife is not your adversary! Your wife is your lover and best friend. Confused and surprised by our amazing insight, husbands often exclaim to us that their wives say these exact words to them all the time! If a husband is full of pride and responding out of insecurity though, he may **create** an adversary out of his wife!

When you listen to the marriage manual in your wife's heart you will appreciate it when she opens up and talks to you about what you are doing that is hurting her or your relationship. This is a key to your growth as a man of God.

"Thanks For Pointing That Out!"

Here is a simple key to success. When your wife points out an area in your life that needs changing, the correct response is "Thanks for pointing that out!"

You have **no idea** how the things you are doing or saying, or not doing or saying, are affecting your wife. Gary Smalley points out that women are like butterflies, men are like bulls!

When the wind blows, a butterfly is blown about and carried wherever it goes. It is sensitive and responsive to the slightest breeze. A hard wind will knock the butterfly to the ground and break its wings. It will lie on the ground, helpless until it breathes its last. This happens from a simple gust of wind!

The bull on the other hand would not have even noticed that the wind was blowing. For that matter, it would not even notice if it stepped on the gasping butterfly as it struggles for survival.

Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honor unto the wife as unto the weaker vessel

Your aim is to read the marriage manual that is in your wife's heart. This is the means by which you can discover things you can **do** to **be the man of your wife's dreams** and things you can **eliminate** that **hurt** your relationship.

Your biggest challenge is to get her to open up and talk to you honestly about what you can do differently to improve your relationship.

God has given us a gift that will aid us in our efforts! This gift is designed to help us hear our wife's heart concerning things that might be bothering her. If all else fails, your wife's marriage manual will definitely open once a month!

This is why we say that your wife's monthly is your best friend!

"What's that? That time of month is man's best friend! You have got to be kidding me! PMS stands for 'Pack my suitcase!' All that I want to do is get out of here when it is that time of month!"

At one time, I felt the same way. I was convinced that the only reason Kathy would get upset when that time came was because **she** had a problem with which **she** had to deal. This problem had nothing to do with **me** as far as I was concerned. I "felt badly for her" that she would get so **touchy and uptight** but what **really** upset me was that she would **point out things that had been secretly bothering her all month!**

When she would start down this road I would argue with her, "This has not bothered you all month and now, just because you are on your monthly, it's a problem! This is not fair. Just get over it. In three days it won't bother you anymore."

Sure enough, when three days went by the issue would get safely tucked back under the rug. Many times the same issue would suddenly "re-appear" like clockwork... month after month after month. My response was to make a few half-hearted attempts at satisfying her "demand" and then "fluff it off" as soon as the eruption subsided.

What is really going on when this happens? It is very simple. Your wife wants a good relationship with you. She is **desperate** for a **happy** marriage.

All month long your sweetheart puts up with the little, inconsiderate things that you do: the mean looks, the harsh words, the put down sounds. On top of this she has to beg you to do your fair share around the house. I can hear you argue with her, "I work all day, I should not have to help around the house."

All month long, your wife puts up with these childish, immature postures in relationship to your responsibilities as a husband and father.

Suddenly, like a Mack truck, the dreaded monthly hits. Now, your wife's defenses are not as strong. Suddenly, when you hurt her feelings she cannot overlook it as she has done all month.

Suddenly, when you refuse to lend an ear she feels rejected and lashes out at you. The fact that you **bowl** with the **guys** twice a week and only spend **30 minutes** of quality time with **her** has also **suddenly** become an issue.

SUDDENLY, LIKE A MACK TRUCK, THE DREADED MONTHLY HITS. This is it! This is your Best Friend! Why? Because **suddenly** you get a chance to discover areas in which you have to grow!

Suddenly you become painfully aware that you have been acting like an adult child all month and not meeting your wife's needs!

The adult child responds to his wife's every mood, positive **or** negative. When she gets negative he gets even more negative and the situation escalates. This is why these male children cry in unison,

"She made me angry."

"If only **my wife** would get **off** my **case** I would **treat** her better." "She **made** me hit her."

Mature men do not **respond** to their wife's negativity; mature men **initiate** actions or words of love and kindness to meet their wife's need. This brings security and healing.

He grows up emotionally and the dreaded monthly loses all of its power. Her needs are met. He is maturing. Everyone is more peaceful and the relationship is satisfying and fulfilling. The marriage is beginning to look like a marriage made in heaven.

Kathy and I have not had a bad "time of month" together in years! Previous to 1994, they were a living nightmare!

Thank God for this gift! If it were not for "that time of month," you might have gone on living like a child for the remainder of your married life!

Chapter Ten

Why Make The Effort?

He who is married cares about how he may please his wife. She who is married cares about how she may please her husband.

Is this really worth the effort? Many people throw in the towel and find another spouse! Why should we work to have a dream marriage with our currently "flawed" spouse? Why strive to again fall in love with this spouse who has a history of problems when we can simply get divorced and find a better one? I was determined that our children would grow up with two happy and successful parents in an intact home. This would illustrate to them that they could be loving mates for their future spouses. If children do not witness their parents showing affection to one another by hugging, kissing and other acts of appreciation they will grow up without an example of an affectionate marriage.

Randy and Charlotte explained that there had not been much affection shown in either of their families. They were now perpetuating this cycle of not expressing affection to one another or to their children. They were

actually sleeping in separate bedrooms! Their children are learning from them that this is marriage: sleeping in separate bedrooms with little display of affection in public or in private! Sam and Stacy were sitting on their couch holding hands. Their 8-year-old daughter came down the stairs and stared at them. After a long moment she happily turned and went on her merry way. The message that was received by this impressionable 8-year-old from mom and dad was, "All is well on the home front. Your world is safe and secure. We are not going anywhere." In this day of instant marriage and divorce our children must know that their home is safe. It is a place where they can sleep well and play freely, a place where they know mom and dad love and care for each other deeply. This is security!

It was during our **first** pastorate that we were having difficulties in our marriage. I still remember clearly the encounter that we had in the parking lot after church one evening. "Joel, I really need your help. I am getting overwhelmed with the ministry, counseling people, witnessing, the children, (1½ years old and six months respectively) and the house. I need you to help me with more things around the house." Joel's reply was to tell me that I could choose which way it was going to be. Either **he** could run the **house** and **I** run the church or **he** would run the church and **I** would run the household. There was no cooperation, no help; there was no give and take.

Our second year of marriage was especially difficult. One incident I remember clearly was when Joel announced that he was going to be gone for the evening

to watch two movies at the local theatre. I asked him to watch one and come home to spend some time with me. I promised to make a cake and we planned to play a card game, something I enjoyed at the time.

At the end of the first movie, Joel blew into the house. In his rush he did not see the cake that I had made. Joel yelled on his way **back** out the door, "You lied to me!

ALL IS WELL ON THE HOME FRONT. YOUR WORLD IS SAFE AND SECURE. WE ARE NOT GOING ANYWHERE. You told me that you would be waiting for me when I got back and would have a cake ready. You are just trying to control me. You tricked me to get me not to go to the second movie." There was no time for me to

point out to him that the cake was made. Later I explained to Joel that the cake had indeed been ready and how disappointed I was. Joel lightly apologized. Of course! It was easy **after** the deed was done! He had gotten his way at my expense and could "slough" it all off with a simple apology.

Chapter Eleven

Leading As A Team

So that servant came, and shewed his lord these things. Then the **master of the house** said to his servant.

Luke 14:21

Kathy and I have discovered through study of the Word that God desires the husband and wife to lead the home **together** as a **team**. This eliminates the opportunity for the husband to use spiritually abusive phrases such as, "You have to submit to me" and "I am the head of this house."

If God requires that the husband and wife lead the house **together** as a **team**, giving them both the **same job description**, then **teamwork** is required. Communication is required. A **meeting of the hearts** and minds is required.

If there is a decision that absolutely must be made immediately and there is no agreement, it falls on someone to make that final decision. However, this virtually should never happen. I cannot imagine a decision that could not be postponed until the husband and wife are able to reach an agreement or compromise that leaves both parties satisfied. How did Kathy and I

look at this after Life Skills? I asked her, "Kathy, I buy into all of this, but if there is a decision that must be made and we simply cannot agree and it is d-day, do you mind if I still get to make that final decision?" said, "Sure." In 14 years, this has never happened. 14 years later, I realize that was immaturity speaking. The insecurity "final man getting the decision" privilege cultural. It is not a New

Testament concept. We work as a team. We don't even consider this question anymore.

How does this work in the myriad of decisions that must be made on a daily basis? Kathy and I find many times that one of us feels strongly about something and the other one does not really care about the particular issue. In this case there is no debate. We go with the one who feels strongly about the situation.

When I was a control-freak the direction **always** had to originate with me. If Kathy felt strongly about something, it was **all the more** reason for me to pull rank and inform her that I was the head of the house and we were going to do it **my** way.

This is the summary of an argument between Kathy and me in 1986: "Can we go out to dinner Friday night?" "No." "Why not? We normally go out to eat dinner about once a week and it has been a few weeks." "I am the one who picks the nights we go out." "Well that is not fair. I feel like we have not had any quality time and that we need to go out this Friday."

"Would you please drop the subject? I am the head of this house and I will decide when we go out to eat. When it is time, I will tell you. Until then, just leave me alone."

This upset Kathy for a few days until she successfully "swallowed it", reminding herself that she had to "submit in all things except for sin." "Submit in all things except for sin," was the message taught by the then very popular, and now recently divorced "Father of Marriage Ministry" who was an influence in our life at the time. We had been to his seminar in person, purchased and studied the complete 16 tape series with study guide and attempted to assimilate the information. We definitely embraced the submission emphasis of the teachings!

Let's look closer at this idea of leading the home. The first word we will look at is the word "proistemi" (4291 in Strong's), which means "to stand before in rank, to preside or to be over." It is used in Romans 12 when discussing the motivational gifts.

He that ruleth, with diligence;

Romans 12:8

The word for ruling here is not referring only to

men even though it says, "he that ruleth". All of the other motivational gifts of the Spirit listed in Romans would then also have to be reserved exclusively for men such as the gifts of mercy, giving, teaching or

exhortation.

These verses show very clearly that men are to lead the house. Before you get too haughty though, let's take a look at some Bible references that clearly specify that women are also authorized to lead the house.

Therefore I desire that the younger widows marry, bear children, manage the house, give no opportunity to the adversary to speak reproachfully.

1 Timothy 5:14

The word translated here as "manage" the house, means to be the **head of a family!** The Greek word is "oikodespoteo" (3616 in Strong's) which means, "to be the head of" or in other words "to rule" a family.

Now it is getting hot in here.

The King James Version interprets this as to "guide the house". That was a safe translation.

I can imagine that if the translators had translated the word **literally** that women are to be the **head of a family** or **rule the family** there would have been problems. They might have heard the much feared words from the king, "Off with his head!"

The word we just looked at, "oikodespoteo," is taken from the word "oikodespotes," which means exactly the same thing: to be the head of a family. King James translates this in other verses as "goodman of the house", "householder" and "master of the house."

For the kingdom of heaven is like unto a man that is an householder, which went out early in the morning to hire laborers into his vineyard.

Matthew 20:1

The word used in Matthew 20:1 to describe a wife's leadership in the home is "householder". This person was **in charge!** He hired the laborers. This is a parable describing leadership in the same way that a wife is authorized to be the head of the house.

So that servant came, and shewed his lord these things. Then the **master of the house** being angry said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind.

Luke 14:21

Here the word is translated "master of the house". This is what the wife is supposed to be! The master of the house! How can this be? How can God tell both the husband and wife to be the head of the house together?

HE IS GOD! God planned it this way! God's plan for leadership in your home is one of team leadership and mutual submission. Another word to describe mutual submission would be mutual "adaptation".

What are we after? We are after teamwork and mutual respect when it comes to leading the family unit. That is what the Bible teaches; husbands and wives working together, leading their home as a team. The two become ONE!

Chapter Twelve

Your Wife Ain't Your Momma!

(And You Are NOT Her Old Man!)

In the last chapter, we discovered that God has authorized wives as well as their husbands to lead the home as a team in unity and harmony. Titus 2:5 talks about wives being "keepers at home." This is the Greek word "oikourgos", meaning "to be a guard, domestically inclined and a good housekeeper." Husbands like this one! However, as we are learning, we always act as a team.

We have four children. I pitch in around our house by doing laundry and anything else Kathy asks me to do. One thing that I do is wipe down the commodes when I notice they need it. I am especially good at reminding the kids to do their chores! This actually helps, as sometimes Kathy gets so wrapped up in her business that the kids get away with "forgetting" until I remind them!

Helping around the house is an easy way for you to lighten the load. Your wife is not your "momma". Pick up your dirty socks and underwear! Hopefully your momma taught you to clean your room and you continued the

habit after you were married! If you were a slob as a single man or if your momma **did** pick up after you, that changes now!

Your wife ain't your momma **or** your personal housekeeper! She is your lover and your best friend! Help around the house! Hire a housecleaner! Do something. Do anything! As long as you are lightening the load off of your wife's back, you are doing a good thing.

Comparable

And the Lord God said, "It is not good that man Should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him."

Genesis 2:18

When you married, you did not marry up or down.

This may come as surprise, as in many marriages one of partners invariably feels like they married "below his or her level". This is simply not so. A man's wife is comparable to her husband. bills Two \$1,000 are comparable, period. One is not better than the other!

In the beginning of our marriage I felt as though I were superior to Kathy. When I began to grow into the

man God called me to be by becoming the husband my wife needed me to be, things started to look different. I realized how incredible Kathy was. I began to realize how strong she had been to survive the bad years. I realized what a wonderful wife and lover she was. She was my equal in every way! This was a revolution in my marriage. I did not marry down; therefore I could not **look down** on Kathy.

I now know that it was because I was afraid of losing her. By making her feel inadequate I thought that I could keep her under my thumb. By tarnishing her self-

image I could make her "feel" like she was fortunate to be married to me. If she lost me she would not be able to attract a quality guy. I rescued her from a low life!

The real kicker to this scenario is that Kathy had fit perfectly the "list" of positive qualities that I had been looking for in a wife. She was fun loving, pretty,

smart, outgoing, wanted to minister with me, enjoyed singing and would be able to write books with me. God had given me everything that I had asked for in a wife and I was constantly belittling her and putting her down.

When Kathy makes a mistake now, I remind myself of a time I have made the same mistake. If I have not made that same mistake, I try to remind myself of something else I am working on in which Kathy is already strong.

Kathy is extremely busy with our four children, ministry, blessing me and being friends with everyone that she meets. If you need to be encouraged or counseled, just hint to Kathy that you have a need. She will pour her heart out in attempting to encourage you. I love this about Kathy. The backside of both Kathy and me being busy in all of the activities is that we will sometimes forget details.

The fact is that no one marries above or below his or her level. You may have **different weaknesses and different strengths** than your spouse, but you are neither superior nor inferior to them. Learn to roll with, appreciate and laugh at these differences.

Point taken. God made man. Male and female he created them. Both are created equally. Man is a general term for men and women. Male and female together equals "man".

Every man has his own unique justification for his controlling nature.

Italian men say that they will be a "schlep" if they respect their wives and give them too much freedom.

Egyptian and **Moslem** men blame their controlling nature on their culture.

Men from many Latin cultures say that real men are independent. A little control and a half dozen affairs are just part of a normal relationship!

Christian men justify their controlling and manipulative nature by the usage of scripture.

Every man's controlling nature proceeds from the same fallen nature. Control and manipulation are the result of the fall. "Your wife will have a desire for you and you will rule, like a dictatorial tyrant, over her."

A sure sign that a man is being healed of his abusive tendencies is when he accepts the fact that his wife is not "below him". She is his perfectly capable, comparable and God-ordained equal. Your wife is not your "momma" and you are not her "old man". You are lovers, friends, teammates and equals.

God desires that you honor **Him** by **loving each other deeply.** You are not above your wife and she is not above you. You mutually adapt to one another and you grow into the man that God has called you to be by becoming the husband that she needs you to be.

Chapter Thirteen

Shining Your Crown

An excellent wife is the crown of her husband.

Proverbs 12:4

A crown to a king is his most prized and valuable possession. A king's crown is his glory. A king's crown represents him. A king's pride and joy is when his crown sparkles and shines. If his crown gets even a smudge, it is immediately cleaned to a sparkling shine again.

If my wife is my crown then I want her to shine! How can I shine her? I shine my crown by praising her. I shine my crown by building her up. I shine my crown by complimenting her.

As I build up Kathy she becomes very secure. When she is secure, the inner beauty that God has graced her with is poured out upon me! I reap the benefit! As I validate Kathy by reinforcing the high value that I place upon her she makes it her mission to be the best person that she can be! Kathy's confidence manifests itself in both inward and outward beauty! We have it easy, guys!

God created our wives to desire us. When we treat them well they naturally blossom like a rose.

We want to shine our crowns. When we shine our wives, they in turn will search out ways to increase their shine value to us, both inwardly and outwardly.

Another expense that I never resent spending money on is make-up! Kathy **studies** make-up and

I WANT HER TO LOOK AND FEEL GREAT! SHE IS MY CROWN! fashion styles. As my crown I appreciate that she knows how to shine! One woman said to my wife, "I feel like God told me to tell you to throw away all of your fashion magazines. You are beautiful enough!" The

visitor may have been complimenting my wife but I can guarantee that God was not telling Kathy to throw away all of her style and beauty magazines! (On the other hand, this second-time church visitor may have been trying to present her personal opinion as the voice of God! We never **did** see her again!)

Guys, if you expect your wife to dress sharply and look good, you have to be sure that she has money and that she has your blessing to spend that money on herself. This is especially important if you have children.

We have seen numerous instances where the husband and children were always dressed in nice new clothes while mom, placing herself on the bottom of the totem pole, is wearing clothes that are eight to ten years old. If your wife can't bring herself to spend money on herself, go on a shopping date together!

Remember, if funds are tight many upscale

consignment shops offer upscale clothes for pennies on the dollar. These clothes are often beautiful and look like new. I cannot count the times that Kathy has modeled an incredible new shirt or outfit for me that she has bought at a nice resale shop. I will be thinking that it cost \$100 on sale! When I ask what it cost she

gives me the victorious announcement: "Two dollars!" The woman has a gift!

I appreciate it when Kathy looks really good and I appreciate it when she sometimes has a bit of a "sexy" edge to her outfit for the day. I much prefer looking at my own wife with interest rather than noticing other women! It would not be healthy for me to notice how nice another lady looks and then to look at Kathy, desiring that she dressed more appealing.

Revealing outfits are to the point of ridiculous in our world today. A Christian wife is not competing with

the scantily clad, airbrushed, augmented billboard models that confront her husband every day. Having said that, most Christian husbands enjoy their wives looking "sexy," in a modest way, occasionally!

Men in general notice attractive women. Period. End of story. Right or wrong. Good or bad. They just do.

Charlie Shedd settled that issue many years ago in his classic work, "Letters to Phillip". Kathy does not mind that I notice. What she does mind though is that "second look!" Everyone knows what I mean by "second look!" You are **not** shining your crown when you make an

effort for a second look. That second look devalues your wife instead of building her up.

This is all about shining your wife! She is your crown! Be glad when she glows and looks beautiful.

Your wife's "glow" is representing to the world that her husband treats her with the same honor that he would treat a multi-million dollar crown! Build your wife up. She represents you! Encourage her to learn about fashion and style. Be happy when she is going out into the community looking good and representing you in style! Shine your crown always. She is the best part of you.

The Bible says that an excellent wife is the crown of her husband. I want to be an excellent wife and I want to be a crown that is just as valuable to my man as a crown is to a king! A crown represents the king's value! A crown makes a king look good! That is one of my goals as an excellent wife! To make my husband look good! I want him to be proud of me to the point that he brags and shows me off!

Esther spent six months soaking in Oil of Myrrh and another six months with other perfumes and beauty preparations. We cannot spend a year soaking in perfumes and oil of myrrh but we **can regularly improve our appearance.** Just the fact that you are working on it regularly qualifies you as "The Woman of His". Your man will be thrilled that you are getting better looking every day! You have not given up!

Every marriage book emphasizes a woman's inner beauty. Suffice to say that it is not good for a woman to be ugly, mean, unkind and unmerciful on the inside. It has been proven time and again that these negative attributes in a wife's personality will "go away" when a man becomes the husband that his wife needs him to be. A wife who is a believer and wants to please God will be beautiful on the inside as her husband becomes the man that God has called him to be! It is hard to be beautiful on the inside if your husband is tarnishing your self-image daily!

A shining crown will be beautiful on the inside and will utilize everything that she has been given by God to be beautiful for her husband on the outside. Who gets the credit when the crown is shining? Your husband! You will shine in direct relation to how you are being treated behind closed doors.

Enhance Your Husband!

A crown enhances the king who wears it. My goal is to enhance my husband. I want to do simple things like making him a cup of coffee or bringing him a glass of juice. I do things that lift his load when I am able. Asking him if there is anything that I can do to help him is another way to enhance his day.

I always make it a point to look my best. I put makeup on everyday and dress in ways that are pleasing to him. If you have certain clothes that your husband does not like, my question is "Why would you wear it?" If my husband does not like an outfit, out it goes! Sometimes I will work with it to make it look nice but if it still does not "turn him on", out it goes!

I also make it a point to look good when we go to bed. Years ago I read that Lynette Hagin's husband, Ken Jr. had not seen her without make-up! She went to bed in make-up, got up to remove it after he fell asleep and rose before Ken in the morning to reapply. I do not do that but I always look good for Joel! You don't have to go overboard, but if your husband says that he does not care how you look when you go to bed, don't believe him! I don't go to bed in hair rollers or flannel PJ's! You will

never find me displaying an attitude of "I don't care how I look". There are times that the day gets going before the make-up goes on but at the first opportunity I will be at the mirror "beautifying!" Speaking of bedtime, Joel and I go to bed at the same time 90% of the time. How can you

You would think that I could focus on (reading, working, studying) but no... You come and change clothes right in my line of view!" I just love it!

Chapter Fourteen

Submit? Adapt?

Submitting to one another in the fear of God.

Ephesians 5:21

Submit. Adapt. Submit. Adapt. Submit? Adapt? What is this all about? Frankly, Kathy and I like to use the word "adapt" in place of the word "submit". Why? One reason is that "adapt" is a friendly word which more accurately reflects the biblical intention of the word.

The word "submit" for many people has a negative connotation.

In the early 60's, teaching about marriage became popular in the Body of Christ. The emphasis was placed solely upon the woman to "submit" to her husband; the man of the house; the head of the home; the king of the castle. Women were expected to be everything and do everything that her husband could ever hope or want regardless of how he acted and treated her.

The wife was never to complain or argue and was instructed to constantly tell him how wonderful he was. If the dutiful, submissive wife were ever to try to "usurp his authority" by asking him why he was home late for dinner or what he spent all the money on then she was "in rebellion."

Many women will remember the book Total Marabel Woman bv Morgan. This young lady of about 30 years of age stormed the country with her best selling book and appeared on national TV programs with her revolutionary message of submission. Her theory? If only the wife were do everything perfect, then husband her would

become a responsible, loving husband and they would have a wonderful marriage.

I don't think so. There **were** testimonies of husbands who indeed were pleasantly surprised at the change in their wives. She recommended lots of fun sex, cute outfits, adoring words and beautifully prepared meals with no negative words, thoughts or feelings ever to be projected toward the husband. I still like the fun sex, cute

outfits, adoring words and Kathy's cooking! Let's not throw the baby out with the bath water!

We teach that women are **designed by God** to **desire** their husbands. **If** a **husband** will **lay his life down** for his wife and meet **her** needs, she will **want** to do these things for him. She won't be **forcing** herself in order to keep peace and appease him. Yes, there may be an uncomfortable season of healing needed before a wife can "go there" – to that place of "wanting" to respond warmly and positively to a husband, but regardless of the necessary time, that is the end result. Our second book, *Livin' It and Lovin' It!* covers this process in detail.

The biblical usage of the word "submit" is most often translated from the Greek word "hupotasso". We find "Hupotasso" in Ephesians 5:21. "Submitting yourselves one to another". The word means "to subordinate, to obey, to be subject to and to submit oneself to." In the very next verse we find these words:

Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

Ephesians 5:22

The net effect of this double usage of the word "submit" in back to back verses is that men totally ignore the fact that verse 21 requires **mutual submission**. The word "submit" therefore has only been applied to the wife submitting to her husband. Haven't you heard? "A husband is **never** told to submit to his wife. Heresy!"

The word "submit," as found in the preceding verses, has for years been mistakenly taught as being the exclusive responsibility of the wife in a Christian marriage.

A foundation of teaching was built – and has been sustained since the early 60's - that a woman was solely responsible for the success or failure of her marriage. This

theory is that if a woman will only submit enough to her husband, her submission will tame the beast and he will not be abusive toward her. For years this was the complete emphasis of all marriage teaching in the church. A woman was to relegate herself to being a doormat to be walked upon with a smile on her face, a song in

her voice and dinner on the stove while at all times being ready for rollicking good times in the bedroom!

The sad result was that this misguided emphasis simply gave men a **new way to abuse their wives.** Now they had the **Bible** behind them. A husband could yell and scream at his wife and say it was because she was not submissive. He could be immature, not clean up after himself, stay out all night, and spend the family's money. If his wife were to object he could tell her she was in rebellion. If he wanted to pull out the big guns he would claim that she had a "Jezebel" spirit.

Of course, most pastors agreed with the husbands. Most pastors were men. Their wives **were** rebellious. In some churches it could be reported that **every single woman** was a carrier of the "Jezebel spirit". This new form of abuse has been coined "spiritual abuse." It goes on today behind the closed doors of Christian homes (and churches) more than anyone would ever want to admit.

If your wife is solely responsible for the success of your marriage, what is there left for you to do? When I realized that I was waiting for Kathy to be the perfect wife, I was shocked. Here I was; the "Man of God with the Power for the Hour" and the only answer I had for our problems was to blame Kathy, claiming that she was just not submissive enough. I abused her spiritually on a regular basis, using Bible verses to "hit" her with, or at the very least, to hold her in "check". When I learned to listen to her heart, mutually adapt (submit) to her, and meet her needs, our marriage was miraculously restored to the outrageously happy relationship we enjoy today.

Chapter Fifteen

Adapting To One Another

Submitting to one another in the fear of God.

Ephesians 5:21

Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

Ephesians 5:22

The word "submit" which is translated from the Greek word "hupotasso" is found in Ephesians 5:21. It is used in reference to submitting **one to another**. The very next verse then goes on to repeat the English word "submit," instructing wives **specifically** to submit to their husbands.

I always found this to be very odd. Why would God tell believers to submit one to another and then immediately tell wives separately and specifically to submit to their husbands? The way my Bible reads is like this: "Submitting yourselves to one another. Wives, submit to your own husbands as to the Lord." This just does not make any sense. In general, if the Bible does

not make sense, there is something lost in the translation. That surely is the case here.

Wives, **submit** to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

Ephesians 5:22

"Submit" in this verse is not the word "hupotasso" being repeated, as it seems. Here comes the definition of this word for submit. The Greek word is a little different from the word "hupotasso". Are you ready for this? Be sure to read slowly and emphasize each and every word! The definition, according to Thayer's Greek Dictionary is:

"Inserted word: This word was added by the translators for better readability in the English. There is no actual word in the Greek text!"

(Thayer's #9999)

You have got to be kidding me! No, I am not kidding. And it gets even better. If you take the word "submit" out of the verse, it reads like this: **"Wives, unto your own husbands as unto the Lord".** The word translated "unto your own" is the word "idios" which means, "pertaining to self, one's own, private or separate." (Strong's #2398)

The verse would be literally translated much better if you read it like this:

Let the wife be private and separate to her husband as she is to the Lord.

Now this makes sense. Anyone can understand this. "Submit one to another and you wives, be private and separate unto your own husband as unto the Lord. Be faithful to your husband. Be set apart solely for him. Don't let another man get into your 'space'. Your space is reserved exclusively for your husband." One thing that

has always impressed me about Kathy is how private and separate that she is to me. I often thought that Kathy would be tempted to have an affair after I did. This is not how Kathy thinks or acts. She has had opportunities at vulnerable times yet has maintained herself private and separate. It is awe-inspiring to see and I am grateful for this

Mutual Submission

There are later legitimate uses of the word "hupotasso" as relating to wives but it is always in tandem with a mutual submission, respect, adaptation and love. For example:

Wives, submit to your own husbands, as is fitting in the Lord. Husbands, love your wives and do not be bitter toward them. Colossians 3:18-19

Here the word "submit" is used in tandem with husbands being instructed to love their wives. We look at husbands loving their wives in Chapter 17.

Then "hupotasso" is used as it relates to a team ministry such as in a church service.

For you can all prophesy one by one that all may learn and all may be encouraged. And the **spirits** of the prophets are subject to the prophets.

1 Corinthians 14:31-32

This is simply telling us that a prophet does not **have** to speak when he has a word. He instead can choose to flow in harmony and wait his turn to speak.

Next, the Bible uses the word "hupotasso" in regards to submitting to leadership as in this example:

... They have devoted themselves to the ministry of the saints—that you also **submit to such**, and to everyone who works and labors with us.

1 Corinthians 16:15-16

This again is a request to work together as a team, flowing in love, joy, peace and unity. Remember our opening verse at the beginning of this chapter?

Submitting to one another.

Ephesians 5:21

In 1 Peter the word "hupotasso" is used again, reminding everyone to be submissive to one another.

Yes, all of you be submissive to one another and be clothed with humility.

1 Peter 5:5b

Same word: "hupotasso". That about says it all. Everyone should walk in a spirit of harmony, a spirit of adapting. We should all get along without anyone demanding his or her own way. We should look out for the interest of others and not just for "number one." That is what the word "hupotasso" is communicating.

The verses telling wives to submit to their husbands are **not** to be used against wives in order to force them to put up with abusive behavior from their husband. Submit is a loving word that would be interpreted better as "to adapt" or to simply "flow together as a team, preferring one another".

Chapter Sixteen

Desiring Your Husband Is A Good Thing

Your **desire** shall be **for your husband**. Genesis 3:16

We want women to have a **desire** for their husbands. Our aim is to help a man become the **husband** his wife **needs** him to be so that he can become the **man** that **God** has **called him** to become. If he will **do** this, his wife will fall back in love with him! What godly wife does not **hungrily desire a man who is everything that God** has called him to be?

Every woman wants a man who treats her like a queen. Every woman wants a man who places her in the rightful position of number one in his life (with only God being more supreme). We teach men that they cannot claim to love God if they do not intensely love their wife. We boldly teach women that if her husband truly loves God then he will truly love her as a result.

A man **demonstrates** his love for God by how well he loves his wife and children. Every woman wants a man who listens to her, is gentle and kind to her and supports her financially, spiritually, mentally and emotionally. Every woman wants a man who only has eyes for her.

If you are this woman then you will feel free to **desire** your husband. God **wants** you to desire your husband, communicate with him, serve him, bless him and spend time with him. This is God's desired response from you toward your godly and loving husband.

Think back to when you were first married. You desired your husband didn't you? Of course you did! You desired your husband and you were proud of that fact. You bragged to your friends about this wonderful guy you met. You laid awake at night thinking how wonderful it would be to marry this "knight in shining armor." All of your childhood dreams were coming true! You thought about him constantly. You dreamed about that perfect, secure, safe, romantic "happily ever after" life with this perfectly wonderful, delightful man.

Hurt over and over again, you felt cheated by life. The dream you had as a young girl became a distant memory. Now when you see a kind and loving gentleman you fantasize over what "could have been" had you met him instead of the heel you know as your husband!

You are now living in a **cold war** with this man that you don't feel much for. Oh yes, you do have some good times. You go out with friends and/or to church. You laugh, you play, you eat together and you take the kids to ballgames. You are living life but there is **no passion!** There is no **love play!** There is no **excitement** about meeting each other in bed tonight. You are two people who live together, accomplish life together, raise children together and go to church but you are **not** two passionate lovers.

You would **not** describe yourself as being madly, wildly or radiantly in love. Those are the **last words** that

you would use to describe your marriage. "Who? Tom and me? Wildly and radiantly in love with each other? I don't think so! We put up with each other, sometimes! We survive each other. We might make it until death do us part and

we might **not. Who knows?** I really don't believe in divorce but we really are incompatible. At least we are staying together until the kids are grown. That is staying together longer than most couples."

Now your husband is reading this book. **Suddenly** he is telling you that he cares about your feelings. **Suddenly** he is helping you with the children and with the dishes. **Suddenly** he is working and paying the bills. Suddenly he is asking **you** to tell **him** what **he** needs to do differently in order **to become the husband that you**

need him to be! Suddenly he is doing those things that you begged him to do years ago in futility until you finally gave up trying!

A sign of the beginnings of maturity would be if your husband understands that his simple apology does not immediately erase your pain. He has inflicted emotional damage upon you, in some cases for years. A key to his growth into the man that God has called him to be is to accept responsibility for the pain that he has caused you by his abuse, mistreatment or unfaithfulness.

Your husband is growing. He is changing. He is treating you with kindness and showing you sensitivity. He has been doing this now for a total of 48 hours since he has been reading this book! He is now a legend in his own mind! (This is really how guys think!) He has made the decision to be your

"knight in shining armor". He is determined to be your dream husband. He is acting and speaking differently.

Perhaps the next time that he is insensitive to you, you calmly inform him that he has hurt your feelings.

Instead of defending himself, your **new husband** says to you, "I'm sorry. I did not mean to hurt your feelings. Thanks for telling me. I will be more careful next time to consider your feelings."

Again, you **crumple** in **utter and complete** shock!

A WOMAN'S MISERY WAS THAT THE MAN SHE SO DESIRED WOULD RULE HER LIKE A TYRANT. Now you are in a pickle! Do you trust him? What do you do? How do you handle this? The first and most important thing is that you begin to respond to him. Act like you have feelings for him. Go out of your way to perform special

actions of love toward him. Begin to do things that you know will make him feel happy and comfortable.

If he will continue to change you will slowly find yourself believing that it is **safe** for you to **desire** him again. It is safe to **take those dreams off of the shelf** and begin to fantasize about being married to the man of your dreams because "the heel" is starting to morph into **that man!** Surprise, surprise, surprise!

Pretty soon you can unreservedly begin to desire him. This is a good thing. God's plan from the very beginning has been for a wife to desire her husband.

With the fall came a curse: "your husband will **rule** over you." The word "rule" brings to mind the idea of "ruling like a tyrant". It is the Hebrew word, "mashal" meaning "to rule, to have dominion, to have power over." More often than not, when it appears in the Word, it refers to harsh and ungodly rulers. That certainly is the usage of the word in this reference. It was not God's **original intention** that your husband would tyrannize you. It was a result of the curse of the law.

We are teaching your husband to love you as a redeemed man. A redeemed man does not rule over his wife. A redeemed man serves his wife and loves her as Christ loves the church and gave himself for her by laying down his life. A redeemed man is attentive to your needs. A redeemed man dedicates himself to loving his wife and children.

The curse is reversed! Your desire is for your husband and he is treating you like the apple of his eye! The better he treats you the more you are safe to unreservedly desire him. What is your desired end? You want to feel safe enough to love him without reservation and never look back.

Gone are the days of constant bickering, insults, disrespect, humiliation, shame, manipulation and control. It is a new day — a day of love, fun, freedom, romance and joy! This new man **is** the man of your dreams.

Husband, Love Your Wife: Your Lover, Confidant and Friend

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her.

Five times husbands are instructed to love their wives. The Greek word for love here is "agapao" which is the "God kind of love." The GOD KIND OF LOVE expresses itself in **giving** as illustrated in the scriptures: "For God so LOVED the world that He **gave...**" and "Just as Christ also LOVED the church and **gave** himself for her." **You have a high calling, man of God.** That high calling is to love your wife as Christ loves the church and as God loved by **giving** his only son.

This emphasis was revolutionary in the Jewish world 2000 years ago. Women were considered property

in their culture. Women were expected to bear and raise children. Husbands were responsible to them in nothing. Husbands could come and go as they pleased with no accountability for where they were or what they had done. For Paul to demand

this level of self-sacrifice from men for their women in that day was nothing short of life altering, conscious shattering and total paradigm shifting!!

Paul repeatedly told the husbands to lay their lives down for their wives. This was in complete contradiction to the current religious environment. It should be something that we look at seriously. Every husband **can learn** how to love his wife in this way. It is not an **easy thing** to learn! Men are not born with an innate ability to love their wives. It will be a learned ability – an ability that a husband must learn – if he ever hopes to have a relaxed and happy marriage.

1 John 4:19 says, "We love (Him) because he **first** loved us." Your job is to love **first**. Your wife's job is to love in **response**.

The first prerequisite understanding of love is that **love is a decision**. It is not based on how you feel. A decision is a decision. It is not a feeling. Kathy and I made

it through some very rough years simply because we decided to love. We decided to stay committed. Kathy, of course, got the short end of the stick, as it was my refusal to listen to her heart that caused our problems. Kathy was operating in "agapao" love. In a marriage relationship, this is above and beyond the call of duty for a wife.

When I treated her poorly she **decided** to love me. Many marriage books teach the wife to function in "agapao" love until her husband responds positively to her. Kathy read and applied the message.

This is upside down but sometimes it is the only way a marriage can survive. A man can be so rebellious to meeting his wife's needs that **without** her operating in

"agapao" love the marriage would not have a chance to last long enough for the husband to **learn** how to love. This formula **will lengthen** a marriage but will not help a husband to grow into the man that God has called him to be. A man will never **love his wife** in **response** to her "agapao" loving him. He is not **created** to **respond** to his wife. He is created to initiate – to love first – to serve first.

In faith, Kathy loved me with "agapao" love. Her sacrificial love kept us together long enough for the "Colorado Miracle" to happen. (Kathy was the "husband" and I was the "wife") In classic God-style, Kathy came to the end of her grace at a time coinciding with our receiving the new information. You are now receiving the truth that will set you free. The days of your wife holding your marriage together (being the husband!) are coming to an end. This is your fork in the road. It is our prayer that God will use this book to give to your marriage the same miracle that we received at Colorado! There is no turning back now. Your life can never be the same.

Chapter Eighteen

This word for "love" in Greek is "philandros" and it means "fond of man and affectionate." It is a responsive love. We encourage women to respond to their husbands by being fond and affectionate.

Once, Joel and I were in a convenience store making a purchase. Joel forgot his wallet in the car and asked me if I would go out to the car and get it for him. I said, "Yes, sir!" and turned to go out the door.

With complete and utter astonishment a young man exclaimed to Joel, "How did you do that?" Joel said, "How did I do what?" He said, "That! How did you get her to say 'Yes, sir' and go get your wallet just like that?"

Joel replied, "I treat her like a queen! If you treat your wife like a queen she'll be **happy** to do things for you!"

IF YOU TREAT YOUR WIFE LIKE A QUEEN SHE'LL BE HAPPY TO DO THINGS FOR YOU! Isn't that how you are? When your husband is treating you wonderfully, it is easy to be a blessing to him, isn't it?

If your husband only

realized how much more enjoyable life will be when he finally begins to listen to your heart and treat you like a queen he would certainly become that husband that you need him to be a lot quicker!

If an excellent wife had to choose between living with a less intelligent, less successful man who treated her well or a successful, more intelligent man who treated her poorly, she would choose the former every time.

Brains and success don't hold a candle to gentleness and kindness to an excellent wife. She would

live in a shack with a man who treats her right! Fortunately, you do not have to make that choice! Your husband can be intelligent, successful and yes, he can learn to treat you right!

When your man lays his life down for you and meets your needs then you are enabled to respond by being fond of and affectionate toward him in return.

This is extremely easy to do if you have not been too humiliated, broken and confused by your husband's actions of the past. If you **have** been humiliated and broken it will take time for you to heal and trust again. You might have retreated into a protective shell and may be wary of opening your heart.

You may be afraid to take the risk. Why be hurt again?

If your relationship has been damaged to **this** extent, your husband will have to display that he is sincere over an extended period. **In time** you will trust that it is safe for you to come out of hiding. **In time** you will respond positively to him.

You are able to be the wife of his dreams and you will be in response to him becoming the husband that you need him to be. Are you ready to be his dream wife today? No. Today you want nothing to do with him.

What is his answer? The answer is for your husband to love, love, and love you with that "agapao" love without expecting anything in return.

When we meet a wife who has **no desire** for her husband there are always years of history that killed that response. It is doubtful that **any** woman married a man without having the desire for a great relationship with him!

Chapter Nineteen

If It Doesn't Work At Home, Don't Export It.

(For Ministers)

For an Elder must be a man whose life cannot be spoken against. He must be faithful to his wife.

1 Timothy 3:2 (NLT)

Many couples reading this book **are now** or **will be** called into ministry. The enemy loves to cause marital failure and he takes **special delight** in making a **public display** of his deceptive abilities by putting additional pressure on the marriages of those who are called to ministry.

If a man cannot meet the needs of his own wife, then he **cannot** meet the needs of families in the household of God. A man's first priority in ministry must be to be faithful to his wife physically, spiritually and emotionally.

Ministers are tempted to get their needs met through church work. The enemy of their marriage wants them to spend their best energies on church and on church members. In many ministry environments, ministers' wives are left on the outside looking in.

I remember being told by the "soon departing" elders of our second pastorate that Kathy was not allowed to participate in the elders' meetings. That policy was changed immediately!

Excluded ministry wives sit quietly in the pew watching their husbands getting "oohs" and "ahs" from admiring ministry supporters or congregation members. It is easy for this minister to be unfaithful to his wife by drawing his self-image and self-worth from those in his congregation.

This is a form of emotional adultery.

These longsuffering ministers' wives die inside knowing full well that their husbands are not meeting their needs and not living the life in private that they are attempting to display in public.

When the wife complains, the husband tells her that ministry is his most important call and that she is being rebellious to God to suggest that he slow down in his ministry. This is spiritual abuse.

Many times these relationships continue in misery for years behind closed doors. When one of these wives gets the nerve up to leave, they are ostracized from the

church body. The official word from the leadership is that the wife is in rebellion.

The reality is that the husband is in spiritual and emotional adultery, having neglected his marital responsibilities under the guise of ministry commitment. Ministry is his mistress.

When our marriage was in crisis, I desperately wanted to stay in the pulpit! My thoughts were along the following lines:

WHEN OUR

I DESPERATELY

"It is not all my fault. Divisive church members caused our congregation to go through a messy church split. Kathy was causing me problems. Besides, I came back! I repented! Everyone should just accept me and validate

my immediately continuing in public ministry."

If someone could have looked into our lives at the time they would have seen the truth that Kathy and I were fighting a lot.

I was insisting that we still be friends with the other couple. They agreed. This development put a knife through Kathy's heart. I was still infatuated, in false love

or in lust with the other woman. Pick whatever term you want to use to describe it.

The relationship was broken but there was still a strong soul tie. I had a difficult time letting God circumcise my heart.

Thank God that my character flaws forced me to face the fact that I had to step out of the pulpit for a season to restore my family. Why other ministers sometimes do not realize this, I will never know. It is total and complete deception.

The challenge for your marriage is this: Live the Word. Stay faithful to your wife by putting her first in everything. If you find that you are not having a successful marriage then you should not be exporting what you are living. You know what is going on behind the closed doors of your home. Are you manipulating and devaluing your wife? Is your home a battleground? If so, recognize the problem and fix it. Get some serious counseling. Don't wait until your wife leaves you.

These are spectacular examples. What I am more concerned about is what is going on behind closed doors in **your** home. Do **you** love **your** wife as **Christ** loved the **church** by **laying your life down** for her and meeting her needs as she expresses them?

On the other hand, could you be spiritually and emotionally abusing her while committing spiritual and emotional adultery with your ministry supporters?

- Do you tell people that your wife is in rebellion?
- Do you say that she might have a Jezebel spirit?
- Do you harp on your wife that she has to "submit to you" and remember that you are the "head of the house?"

If your answer is "yes" to any of these questions, you are in need of some serious marriage counsel. Deal with it! Don't hide!

I have openly shared how I mistreated Kathy in all of the above and in many other ways. God has given us supernatural amnesia to not remember all of the individual instances. If it were not for that amnesia we could fill a 1,000-page book describing our experiences.

Our hearts' desire is that *The Man of Her Dreams/The Woman of His!* would help many ministry marriages that are abusive and/or are recovering from adultery. We have asked the Holy Spirit to bring to mind the illustrations that He wanted us to share. If you found yourself in even one illustration and have been helped, we are grateful. Our transparency is being used by God to reach, to touch and to heal.

We would have written this book in the 90's but we had to walk it out. We had to successfully live these principles for a long time before we could share them in writing.

We can now say without a moment's hesitation:

"The principles that have now given us our dream marriage can save any marriage. If a husband and wife utilize these principles, any marriage can be turned around. The worst marriage can become a dream marriage. The most abusive husband can become 'The Man of Her Dreams'. The wife who has been hurt the most can become 'The Woman of His'. If we can do it, so can you."

You can do this. You, man of God, can grow up. You can lay your life down for your wife. You can listen to the Personal Marriage Manual that God has given you in your wife. You can be kind, sensitive, gentle, loving and supportive.

We do not ascribe to the religiously correct concept that sex is "not all that important" in a marriage. We think that it is **very** important and it is clear that the **Bible** gives lovemaking a place of **high importance** in a married couple's life!

I heard Zig Ziglar say this, "Have you heard it taught that a man becomes what he thinks about all day long? I have to disagree. If that premise were true, then every teenage boy would be a *woman!*" A husband is not depraved because he thinks about making love... all the time. This is why God created "multi-tasking".

It is important to remember that bedroom delight starts in the morning and builds throughout the day. If a husband is changing into the man that God has called him to be, then wonderful things are happening. He is becoming more sensitive, gentle and kind. He is not resisting when his wife mentions that he hurt her feelings or did something in an uncaring way.

If a husband treats his wife special all day long, calling her from work to say "Hi", opening car doors, offering attention and hugs, then the bedroom temperature will rise pleasantly all day long! Someone once said that a woman is like a crock-pot and a man is like a microwave. It does not turn me on to think of Kathy as a crock-pot (how sexy is a crock-pot?), but I

have learned to honor the crock-pot theory. All day long is an adventure for Kathy and me!

When it comes time to retire for the evening, don't lose the pleasant mood that has been building! Go to bed at the same time! If you are a night owl then get back up when your partner goes to

sleep. A good aim would be to go to bed at the same time at least five nights a week. That is minimum. It is not possible to stay close as a married couple if you go to bed at different times every night.

A woman is not designed to carry a sexual load without an emotional reward and a man is not designed to carry an emotional load without a sexual reward. This is

part of God's design and plan. Husband, if you meet your wife's emotional needs, she will be more than happy to meet your sexual needs. Sometimes it is a challenge for you to be sensitive and meet your wife's emotional needs and sometimes it is difficult for your wife to be excited about meeting your sexual needs. The more that you meet her emotional needs in the kitchen, living room and dining room, though, the more excited and eager to please she will be in the bedroom; as a response to you becoming more Christlike.

May your fountain be blessed and may you rejoice in the wife of your youth. May her breasts satisfy you always, may you ever be captivated by her love.

Proverbs 5:18-19

If a couple makes love whenever **one** of the partners is interested then your marriage will include **lots** of lovemaking! This is a valid goal for every marriage! Guys are normally more interested in **quantity** and gals are more interested in the **quality**. If you make love **often**, most husbands will be happy with the love life. If you enjoy quality **time** together, most wives will be happy.

What do we recommend? Lots of sex! Lots of variety! Have lovemaking "dates" at times other than right before bedtime. Afternoon and mid-morning delights are great as you have more energy than you do at midnight! There is no such thing as too much lovemaking or too much time spent at any one time!

Words of caution to a husband who is recovering from being a control-freak:

- It is a turn off for most women to participate in any form of lovemaking if her husband is not clean! Take a shower!
- If your wife is hesitant, do not force it. Talk the issues through. Pray together. Let the principles of gentleness and loving kindness guide you.
- If you have children, you cannot have your wife until you have helped with the many demands that come with a busy family: helping children with homework, cleaning dishes, folding laundry, etc.
- In other words, you must **first do** whatever **you** can do **in general** to enable your wife to have an enjoyable and relaxing evening. **Don't relax in the bedroom waiting.** Don't sit around watching TV or going for joy ride to pass the time while your wife helps the kids with the homework, does the dishes and chases after the baby!
- If this subject is causing problems between you, purchase and read *Sheet Music* together! Drop the subject until you have done this.

Let the husband render to his wife the affection due her, and also likewise the wife to her husband.

The wife does not have authority over her own body but the husband does. And likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body but the wife does. Do not deprive one another.

1 Corinthians 7:2b – 5a

You could emphasize this passage in ten different ways arriving at ten different and interesting conclusions every time! If Kathy and I were to paraphrase this passage, it would read like this:

"When a husband wants to make love, his wife should say, 'Let's go for it!' When a wife wants to make love, the husband should say, 'Let's go for it!" A husband should show his wife lots of affection and attention whenever she is interested and his wife should be ready to give him attention and affection when he is interested."

"The wife does not get to tell her husband 'No!' She does not have authority over her body. If he wants it, he gets it! The husband does not get to say 'No' when his wife is interested, either! If she wants his body, she gets it! **She** is in charge of **his** body and **he** is in charge of **hers!** A man or woman should not ever hold back or be resistant, rather they are to be eager and excited participants!" This is pretty straightforward talk from the Word of God concerning a married couple's private life!

Marriage is honorable among all and the bed undefiled...

Hebrews 13:4a

If we were to paraphrase this verse we would say: "Everyone agrees that being married is honorable. The best part is that when you are married your sex life gets to be full of variety, excitement, fun and adventure!" How fun can the private life be for a married Christian couple in the light of these verses? Lots of fun! Rick Godwin pointed out on national television years ago that there are no verses in the Bible telling you that certain sexual positions or acts are wrong. As long as the sex involves only you and your spouse, anything goes! Were we ever glad to hear that from a nationally known and highly esteemed minister of the Gospel!

We suggest that a man listen to his wife's heart in order to become the man that God has called him to be. In light of this we have to speak directly to the ladies about "Adventures in Lovemaking!" We have discovered that in a number of Christian marriages the wife is not comfortable participating in giving and receiving pleasure in varied sexual expressions. Only the most basic form of lovemaking is acceptable. This aversion may stem from sexual experiences that she had before she was a believer. Another possibility is that she may have been sexually abused as a child.

Statistics say that approximately 50% of women were sexually abused at some point in childhood. This is the world we live in. A woman who was sexually abused as a child can be plagued with flashbacks during lovemaking. Sadly, lovemaking becomes a 'trigger' for horrible memories for some victims. It would be totally

normal for this wife to go from "extremely interested" to "no interest" in a flash. She cannot help this. She is still being victimized by the abuse.

A quality husband can live with a few years of lack in some areas of his sex life with his wife if she is truly being healed of serious emotional harm that was done to her as a child. On the other hand, it is an **invalid** application of our teaching for a wife to use it to defend not participating in adventurous lovemaking simply because it is a new experience.

A man also had dreams of what married life was going to be like before he was married; lots of variety in lovemaking topped his list.

There are some very interesting verses in the Song of Solomon. They describe lovemaking as an exciting adventure of exploration and discovery.

I sat down in his shade with great delight and his fruit was sweet to my taste.

Song of Solomon 2:3b

While the King is at his table, my spikenard sends forth its fragrance.

Song of Solomon 1:12

Blow upon my garden that its spices may flow out. Let my beloved come to his garden and eat its pleasant fruits.

Song of Solomon 4:16

If one spouse wants to be more adventurous in the bedroom but this desire is unfulfilled the marriage is unwittingly set up for problems. The rejected spouse will be living with a sense of disappointment. He or she will not be able to enjoy the fulfillment of the honorable, legitimate and scriptural marital desire for a love life that is full of variety and spice!

Occasionally, we meet a **husband** who refuses to initiate lovemaking. His wife expressed a need for sex early in the marriage and he refused. He has regularly denied her ever since. The man who denies his wife sex is no different than the man who refuses to express love and

LOVEMAKING SHOULD BE THE EASIEST PART OF MARRIED LIFE! affirmation to his wife in other ways. He is simply refusing to meet her need. Why? Because he knows she *needs* it to feel emotionally validated and satisfied! This is not a deep

psychological issue. It is selfishness. Nothing more. Nothing less. His wife wants to make love. She wants the closeness and affirmation it represents. Maybe she just has a strong sex drive. He is refusing to meet her need. Plain and simple. It is not a problem with performance. This man normally self-gratifies with pornography. The issue is that he refuses to meet his individual wife's needs. Grow up. Meet your wife's need. Issue solved.

Stress contributes to the loss of interest in sex for many women. If your wife is stressed, make it your priority to lift her load and diminish her stress, thus increasing the potential for great sex! Contributing factors to stress include a new job, a new house, marital discord, a new church, financial pressures, the loss of friends, family or loved ones, fractured relationships and other like issues.

Don't get angry with your wife if her level of interest in sex is low. Eliminate her stress!

Additional words of caution to a husband who is recovering from being a control-freak:

- Sex is designed by God to be fun and a true pleasure for both spouses in giving and receiving.
- You do own your wife's body, but a normal guy realizes that this does not mean that she has to jump when he barks. Recovering control-freaks are in the process of learning what boundaries are. Let your wife tell you if she is feeling pressured.

Their marriage was in crisis. Tom wanted to make love. Bonnie wanted him to work on the house. Making a few repairs - which had been put off for a year - would be a message that he cared for Bonnie and their ten-year-old child. Bonnie would feel secure — and then be happy to make love. A wise and loving man would have worked on that house! Tom was not wise... **or** loving. He refused to "give in." The last we heard, Tom was homeless and

jobless, living out of the trunk of his car. Bonnie hired a handy-man. She and her ten-year-old are doing just fine.

 Be happy with "quickies" when your wife is not in the mood. If your wife ever complains that you are being too rough or causing her discomfort, buy and read the three books we recommended earlier.
